The Options

- Traditional Options:
 - Family Home or Family Buys a Home
 - Host Home / Adult Foster Care
 - Group Home
 - Supported Community Living in Own Scattered Site Home or Apartment
- Planned Options:
 - Planned Mixed-Use Apartments Affordable Housing
 - Intentional Communities

Traditional Options

- Provider Controlled Settings
- Often able to provide supports and services for individuals with disabilities who have higher medical or behavioral needs
- Often provide day services or programs
- Leading Indiana Providers:
 - Indiana MENTOR
 - ResCare Community Living
 - New Hope of Indiana

Southpointe Village

Fishers, IN

- 25% of units for adults with IDD
- Affordable housing

Line Lofts

Indianapolis, IN

- 20% seniors with vision disabilities
- Affordable senior living

North End Apartments

Carmel, IN

- 40 of 168 units for adults w/IDD
- Village of Merici





OASIS Community, Inc.

Lafayette, IN

- Mixed-use 12-20 acre community
- 1-, 2-, and 3BR for-sale homes
- Community Center
- Approximately 60 adults with and without IDD
- Safe, secure neighborhood
- In development





ILADD/Crossbridge Point

Zionsville, IN

- Mixed-use community
- 1-, 2-, and 3BR for-sale homes
- Clubhouse
- Approximately 40-60 adults with and without IDD
- Safe, secure neighborhood
- In development



CASS Housing

Ft. Wayne, IN

- Supportive, affordable housing for adults with IDD
- Independent Living model for adults who can live more independently
- Family Living Model for adults who require more supports (in development)
- Clustered in the same neighborhood
- 6 homes built and occupied by 18 Core Members; more planned





Village of Merici

Lawrence, IN

- Independent apartment living with supports for adults with IDD
- Fort Benjamin Harrison campus –
 20 affordable apartments
- Brunette Apartments (2023) 37 affordable apartments





Damar Village

Decatur Township, IN

- Affordable housing for adults with IDD; rent approximately \$300/mo
- 12 homes for 48 residents; August 2021 move-in
- Next phase is 20 duplexes for 128 residents
- 24/7 supervision paid thru Medicaid
- Village Center building for residents





Logan Hannah and Friends Neighborhood

South Bend, IN

- 4 homes for 14 residents with IDD
- Activities building, gym, horse barn
- Built 2009 by Charlie & Maura Weis; fully occupied
- Acquired by Logan Community Resources in 2019
- Expansion plans dependent on city water and sewer

How to Pay For It

- Rent
 - SSI/SSDI
 - Housing Choice Vouchers (https://www.in.gov/ihcda/programpartners/housing-choice-opportunities-hco/)
- Food
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, or food stamps)
- Supports and Services
 - Home and Community-based Services (HCBS) Waivers
 - Community Integration and Habilitation (CIH)
 - Family Supports Waiver (FSW)
 - Private Pay
